RETURNING TO HONOLULU The LORD began speaking to Corey in regards to returning to Honolulu after Lisa's dad went home to be with the LORD in November 2006. Lisa received clear confirmation from the LORD in October 2007 and Corey heard clearly about the details of the when, how, why, etc. soon after that. We will be planting a church in Honolulu: Hope Chapel Makiki (www.hopechapelmakiki.org). We feel led to start this international church to be a resource church for North Asia as Corey will continue to coordinate the region with Foursquare Missions International from Honolulu. Our moving date is June 2009. Kailie will finish school the first week of June and Malia will be graduating from her Japanese public school in March, preparing for a new school experience in Hawaii by catching-up on her computer skills, reading, writing and math skills in English in the months before our move. Corey's successor is Shigeki Sato, who was originally Corey's assistant when we first moved to Japan, who has since gone on to seminary in the U.S., has been pastoring in Hokkaido, Japan and is now the newly-elected president of the Japan Foursquare denomination. Corey has spent a lot of time sharing and serving with him (nearly 17 years!) as they served together here in Japan. We believe God is going to do even greater works through Pastor Shigeki, his wife Misako and their children, Liz (university), Iwao (high school), and Hikaru (jr.high). We appreciate your prayers for a smooth transition and for us to finish well and complete the work God has given us to do here in Japan. †
