1. A Sense of Mission

B. God’s promise (vv.3-4; See also Deuteronomy 11:24-25)

2. A Sense of Trust

(Joshua 1:5, 9)

A. God’s presence (v.5; See also Exodus 33:12-17)

B. Courage (v.9; See also Deuteronomy 31:6-8, 23)

3. A Sense of Expectation

(Joshua 1:7-8)

A. God’s guidance (vv.7-8; See also Joshua 24:14-15)

B. God’s blessings (vv.7-8; See also Psalm 1:1-3)
