**(Exodus 12:15-20)**

- A. Leaven (vv.15, 17-20; See also John 6:30-58, I Corinthians 5:6-8)
- B. Holy assemblies (v.16; See also Exodus 15:1-21)

### **3. The Smitten Firstborn**

**(Exodus 12:21-51)**

- A. A dividing line between light and darkness (vv.21-30)
- B. Channels of His blessings (vv.31-51)
