## **Introduction**

### **1. The Aroma of Christ**

- A. The anointed King (Isaiah 61:1-2; See also Luke 1:30-37, 3:21-22, 4:14-21)
- B. His anointed people (Isaiah 61:3; See also Acts 2:38-39, II Corinthians 2:14-16)

### **2. The Aroma of New Life**

- A. The resurrection of the dead (Isaiah 61:4-7; See also John 3:3-8, I Peter 2:9)
- B. The eternal covenant (Isaiah 61:8-9; See also Galatians 3:13-14)

### **3. The Aroma of Joy in the Garden**

- A. The joy of the marriage (Isaiah 61:10; See also Revelation 19:6-9)
- B. The joy of the completion (Isaiah 61:11; See also Revelation 19:1-5, 21:1-7)
