“...He said, ‘Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?’ Abraham said, ‘God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son.’ So they went both of them together.” (Genesis 22:7-8, ESV)

Introduction

God used Abraham and raised up Isaac as a “true worshiper.” Today, let’s open the book of Genesis and consider how Abraham made him a disciple.

1. Faith in God

- A. Sharing of His promises (Genesis 17:1-21; See also Genesis 12:7, 13:14-17, 15:4-6)
- B. Testimony of His fulfilled promises (Genesis 21:1-7)

2. Obedience to God

- A. Environment of disciple-making (Genesis 21:8-21)
- B. Victory over trials (Genesis 22:1-2; See also Hebrews 12:4-11)

3. Offering to God

- A. Our own self (Genesis 22:9; See also Romans 12:1)
- B. Our thanksgiving for the Lamb (Genesis 22:13-14; See also John 1:35-36)
