“...The voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low, and the crooked shall become straight, and the rough places shall become level ways, and all flesh shall see the salvation of God.’” (Luke 3:4-6, ESV)

Introduction

Jesus sends us to the people in the wilderness and uses us to shout out His love. Today, let’s look at Luke Chapter 3, and consider what His love is.

1. Salvation from Our Sin (3:1-14)

A. Repentance (vv.1-6; See also Isaiah 52:10)

2. Sending Out of Our Savior (3:15-22)

A. The Holy Spirit and fire (vv.15-20)

B. The anointed King (vv.21-22; See also Psalm 2:6-8)

3. Fulfillment of His Promises (3:23-38)

A. The offspring of David (v.31; See also II Samuel 7:12-13)

B. The offspring of Abraham (v.34; See also Genesis 22:18)

C. The offspring of Adam (v.38; See also Genesis 3:15)
